2 Hunar Vikas Kendras have been set up by the Department of Rural Development, Ludhiana. Youngsters (18 to 40 years, minimum class 5th passed) are being trained to operate sewing machines. This is a 6 month course with a nominal monthly course fee of 500/- . 130 youngsters have completed the course so far and are gainfully employed
