## From the desk of the District Child Protection Officer, Mrs Rashmi Saini

In June, the DCPO supervised the activities of the task force. This is what she had to share:

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) announced the celebration of the culmination of the Child Labour Campaign from 1st June to 30th June 2023. During this period, various activities were carried out in different regions, involving efforts to eliminate child labour. As part of this initiative, a daily action plan was implemented on the ground, where various industries took measures to combat child labour. In the second phase, from 12th June to 16th June 2023, there was a significant increase in the number of industries involved in the initiative with 57 locations on the 12th and 38 on the 13th. Various industries showcased the steps they have taken to eradicate child labour. During the progressive phase from 19th June to 30th June 2023, a wide range of activities were conducted in various industries – both indoor and outdoor. The plan included ensuring practical and substantial verification of the activities performed by industries and aimed to provide an accurate assessment of the activities carried out by industries. It is crucial to emphasize the significant steps taken to eliminate child labour during this journey.
